Key Stage 3

The Key Stage 3 curriculum at Sacred Heart provides a balanced and diverse blend of subjects.

It is designed to provide academic, creative, technological, and active learning for all. The emphasis is on relevant, challenging, and stimulating experiences. This prepares our students for examination courses and gives them a positive attitude to learning in later life.

All students study a range of academic subjects throughout Years 10 and 11.

This allows students to build upon their learning already achieved during Key Stage 3 and includes the core subjects of Religious Studies, English, Mathematics, and Science (including Triple Award) as well as a broad range of option choices. Students can pursue many areas of interest from creativity in the Arts, Music, and Performance, to Technological subjects, Languages, and Humanities.


